Mr. Rouchon:

Our firm represents Asetek, Inc. ("Asetek") in intellectual property matters. Asetek designs and sells liquid cooling systems for computer systems.

As you may be aware, in August 2012, the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office issued U.S. Patent Numbers 8,240,362 ("the '362 patent") and 8,245,764 ("the '764 patent") with several claims directed to liquid cooling systems for computers. Both the '362 patent and the '764 patent are assigned to Asetek. The '362 patent includes 19 claims, and the '764 patent includes 18 claims.

It has come to our attention that Swifttech is offering for sale in the United States an H220 Liquid CPU Cooler through its website and several distributors and resellers. Based on our analysis of an H220 CPU Cooler, this product infringes at least claims 1 and 3-19 of the '362 patent, and claims 1-14 of the '764 patent.

Asetek has spent extensive time and resources developing its liquid cooling technology and vigilantly guards its intellectual property rights. Asetek demands that Swifttech immediately cease its infringing activities, including selling, offering for sale, and importing the H220 CPU Cooler in the United States.
